

# GC Campus



At Dielsdorf, Switzerland, adjacent to Erlen Sports Park, stands the GC Campus, the largest project in the 118-year history of the Grasshopper Club Zurich. The Grasshopper football club built this training center to ensure its future and to promote the popular sport and thus the professional sport. The center is the only such facility in Switzerland and it is open for all teams to use.

The 55,000m<sup>2</sup> facility offers the Grasshoppers durable playing and training fields of four types of construction. This range provides optimal conditions for training and playing throughout the year. GC Campus includes five playing fields – three grass fields and two state-of-the-art synthetic grass fields. The main building has a floor area of 3750 m<sup>2</sup> and includes locker rooms, physiotherapy rooms, offices, a small club café, and rooms for twelve junior players (boarding school). An additional building includes the entrance area for spectators, a kiosk, and material and equipment rooms for facility maintenance.
